Specific Responsibilities:

1. Provide clinical intake evaluations including mental status and diagnostic formulations.
2. Develop treatment plans consistent with person-centered guidelines and utilization management criteria.
3. Provide individual, family and group therapy.
4. Provide effective outpatient crisis intervention and emergency services as needed or directed by supervisor.
5. Effectively and professionally utilize the consultation services of agency psychiatrists as needed.
6. Actively participate in after-hours Emergency Services System.
7. Provide adjunctive treatment, evaluation and consultation services to other NCCMH programs in particular areas of expertise (e.g. psychological testing, biofeedback, etc).
8. Provide consultation and education to other community agencies and organizations on an as needed basis and strive to maintain good interagency relations with community resources.
9. Submit provider activity data and other reports as required.
10. Provide complete and timely documentation of relevant activities in the paper or electronic clinical record and the agency information management system in accordance with agency policy and procedure and Medicaid requirements.
