

How to **Complete Adult CPR, First Aid, AED Training** During Public Health Emergency

PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATION COURSE FOR FA/CPR/AED PROGRAM:

The FA/CPR/AED Provisional Certification Program consists of 2 separate courses; an online learning course for the cognitive (classroom) and an instructor led skill session for skill verification.

New and recertifying participants can complete the blending learning portion of their class and receive a Provisional Certificate which allows the student 90 days (*the 90 may be extended to be in accordance with executive orders*) before taking the Instructor Led Skills Session.

The student will be required to present their Provisional Certification at the beginning of the Instructor Led Skills Session. Once the student successfully completes the skills session, they will receive the standard 2-year certification for FA/CPR/AED.

HOW TO REGISTER:

Complete the Training Registration form (*as you normally do*) and **email** it to providertraining@norcocmh.org .

Providers please remember when registering a participant, we will also need an email address for the student for them to receive the training acknowledgment from American Red Cross.

Within 1 to 3 business days you will receive an email from the American Red Cross. **YOU MUST FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS EXACTLY AS THEY ARE SENT FROM RED CROSS.** Please allow 1½ to 2 hours for your online portion.

When the online portion is completed North Country CMH will contact you with dates/times to complete the instructor led skill session for skill verification.
