

Multifactor Authentication (MFA)

- Sometimes referred to as “2-Factor”
- Standard Authentication
 - User Name + Password
- MFA adds another level with a rotating numerical code
- Other Examples
 - Bank Text Messages
 - Online Accounts confirming logins with an email



MFA Devices- Token

- Token 2
 - Pocket Sized
 - Inexpensive: Ranges from \$25 – \$45 depending on features
 - Compatible with Office 365
 - Easy to use



MFA Devices- Smart Phone App

- App
 - Free Download
 - Can use either Microsoft Authenticator or Google Authenticator
 - Easy setup
- Guidelines
 - Smart Phone must be owned by Company
 - Can not be a shared device



Important Dates

- December 1st, 2020
 - New access will require MFA
- January 15th, 2021
 - All access will require MFA

- Determine which method of authentication works best for you (Smart Phone App, Token)
