Overview

The HCBS Final Rule requires that individuals have free access to their homes and communities and are empowered with the same degree of decision making as individuals who are not HBCS participants.

Individuals must have access to food at any time

Individuals must be allowed to have visitors of their choosing at any time

Residential settings must have bedroom and bathroom doors that are lockable by the individual

Individuals must have the freedom to furnish and decorate their rooms however they choose

Individuals must have a choice of roommate if possible

Individuals must have the freedom to control their schedule, activities, and resources

House Rules are not permitted

Individuals must have a lease or similar renter protections (residential agreement plus discharge rights)

ESTABLISHED TIME LIMITS FOR PERIODIC REVIEW OF MODIFICATIONS




